MARION FAMILY YMCA NOTICE OF POSITION VACANCY Summer Camp Counselor

Position Overview: Under the direction of the Program Director and in accordance with the Strategic Road Map of the Marion Family YMCA, the Camp Counselor is responsible for assisting with the overall operation of all summer day camp activities and leading activities for a group of campers that helps develop their individual potentials. Incumbent must role model the YMCA values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility and work daily to develop personal and meaningful relationships with members, volunteers, staff and donors.



Position Requirements: Position requires a person with 2 or 4 years of experience related to education or recreation, or demonstrates leadership and patience working with children. Must be at least 18 years of age. Person must have a personality that reflects a love of children, can understand and meet their wide variety of needs, and is creative and spontaneous. Prior camp experience is preferred. CPR and First Aid certifications are required. Incumbent must complete YMCA Child Abuse Identification and Prevention and YMCA 101 prior to the first day of camp.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: Incumbent must be able to move easily across a variety of indoor and outdoor terrain; participate in typical outdoor children's games, sports and activities; watch and listen to the activities of a group of children; lift up to 50 pounds; and spend up to eight hours per day outside in a variety of summer weather conditions.

WAGE RANGE: \$8.60 – 9.25 per hour
