MARION FAMILY YMCA NOTICE OF POSITION VACANCY Aquatics Coordinator

Position Overview: Under the direction of the Program Director and in accordance with the Strategic Road Map of the Marion Family YMCA, the Aquatics Coordinator is responsible for the general coordination and implementation of the swim lesson program; oversees the aquatic staff including lifeguards, instructors; maintains a safe and healthy aquatic environment; develops and implements programs; and acts as Assistant Swim Team Coach. Incumbent must role model the YMCA values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility and work daily to develop personal and meaningful relationships with members, staff, and guests.

The Marion Family YMCA W. Keith Davis Natatorium has an 8 lane competitive pool, warm water therapy pool and whirlpool spa. Current aquatic programs include a comprehensive instructional swimming lesson program utilizing the new Y curriculum, a competitive swim team with approximately 40 swimmers, lifeguard training and specialty programs.

Position Requirements: Position requires a person with some experience in aquatic facility and program management. Incumbent should hold current YMCA or American Red Cross aquatic certifications including Lifeguard and Y Swim Instructor. Additional needed skills include an understanding of the YMCA as a cause-driven organization and the ability to communicate effectively with people of all ages and backgrounds. CPR Pro and First Aid certifications also required.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: Incumbent must be able to meet physical requirements to hold aquatic certifications including but not limited to lifeguard and swim instructor; and meet all physical requirements of Lifeguard and Swim Instructor position descriptions. Must also be able to communicate effectively with people; use a phone; and use a computer with a keyboard.

WAGE: \$11.40-\$15.00 per hour

POSITION STATUS & INFORMATION

- Fulltime nonexempt 40 hours per week of which 65-75% will be hands on teaching swim lessons, coaching swim team, lifeguarding or as a Relationship Manager.
- Work schedule will include days, evenings and weekends.
