Position Overview: Under the direction of the Program Manager, and in accordance with the Strategic Road Map of the Marion Family YMCA, the Tumbling Instructor is responsible for assisting with the overall operation of tumbling classes and leading activities for a group of children that helps develop their individual potentials. Incumbent must role model the YMCA values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility and work daily to develop personal and meaningful relationships with members, volunteers, staff and donors.

Position Requirements: Position requires a person with 2 or 4 years of experience related to tumbling, and demonstrates leadership and patience working with children. Must be at least 18 years of age. Person must have a personality that reflects a love of children, can understand and meet their wide variety of needs, and is creative and spontaneous. CPR and First Aid certifications are required. Incumbent must complete all YMCA-related trainings.

Physical Requirements: Incumbent must be able to move easily across a variety of indoor and outdoor terrain; watch and listen to the activities of a group of children; and lift up to 50 pounds.
