

## Full Time Maintenance Technician at the Marion Family YMCA Impact your Community

Each day brings new challenges as you maintain a 90,000 square foot facility with 18 HVAC units, six boilers, over 100 pieces of exercise equipment, two pools and a hot tub, numerous motors as well as typical electrical and plumbing systems. In addition, we have approximately 20 acres of land with sport fields and a community garden.

As the Y's Maintenance Technician, you'd be responsible for performing HVAC preventative maintenance, routine HVAC repairs, routine equipment maintenance & repairs, and emergency janitorial & maintenance duties to ensure the cleanliness and upkeep of the YMCA facility and grounds.

Your work would provide the backbone of support that ensures the Y nurtures the potential of youth, helps people be healthy and well, and provides opportunities for people to connect with one another.

**Position Requirements:** Must be at least 21 years of age. Three (3) or more years' experience in facility maintenance or closely related field preferred. Must have experience performing HVAC preventative maintenance; and working knowledge / trouble shooting experience with electrical and plumbing systems, and other maintenance-related areas.

Ability to be on call nights and weekends, and respond quickly to emergencies. Ability and current license to drive with record that meets YMCA standards. Must be able to carry out instructions and work independently; understand written and/or oral instructions; read and interpret documents such as safety rules, operating maintenance instructions and procedure manuals. First Aid and CPR with AED certifications are required but may be obtained within 90 days of employment. Physical requirements will be shared during initial interviews.

Wage Range: \$16.00 - \$18.00 per hour
